Email Scam Alert: Recently individuals have been contacted by email by someone pretending to be a priest from our Diocese, asking for gift cards, such as iTunes cards. This is a variation on a scam which occurs quite frequently throughout the United States. Be very cautious in providing any unknown or suspicious contact with personal information, including your contact information or financial information. Verify any request for money through a separate contact, such as the individual's known email address, calling the individual, or contacting the Chancery, Catholic Charities or your local parish or school.

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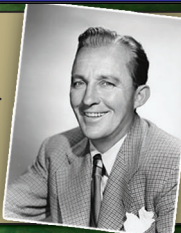


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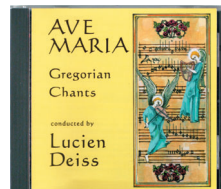
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
