The William H. (Bill) Simon Scholarship Fund: awards scholarships to Catholic students who are in financial need for the purpose of attending an accredited college or university of the student's choice. 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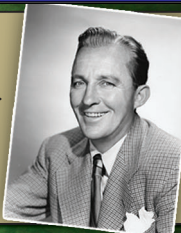


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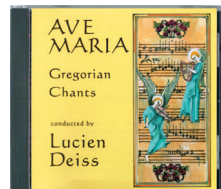
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
