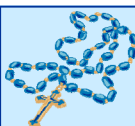

From the Pastor's Desk

Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

Today's feast of the **Immaculate Heart of Mary**, bids us to contemplate on Mary's total desire to fulfill the Father's Will; the maternal role as Mother of Jesus; and her compassionate love for all her children—you and I—as gifted by the Crucified Lord. The interior self of Mary constantly contemplated what God desired of her. Mary was resolute in her "Yes" to God, despite the many sufferings and difficulties it would cause her in this world. Never did Mary waver in her trust and love of the Father and the Son, and overshadowed by the Holy Spirit, found her solace and her strength in carrying out her role as Mother and disciple.

This is the Patronal Feast of our diocese, and contemplating on this mystery, we are to model our lives after our Blessed Mother, seeking always to cooperate in God's plan in bringing the joy of her Son's gospel to all by our words and actions. May we, like Mary, be fervent and faithful in our discipleship of her Son, and, through her intercession, be nourished and strengthened through the mystery and maternal love of her Immaculate Heart.

This Thursday, **July 4th, is Independence Day**, a national holiday, celebrating the beginning of our nation. Mass will be celebrated in the church on this day at **9:00 a.m.** In observation of this holiday, the **Parish Office will be closed on the 4th.**

Since Lent, the special blessing for couples celebrating wedding anniversaries was omitted due to the solemn blessings during the Seasons of Lent and Easter. The Order of Celebrating Matrimony provides "The Order of Blessing Married Couples Within Mass on the Anniversary of Marriage," (#237): "On the main anniversaries of Marriage, as for example, on the twenty-fifth, fiftieth, or sixtieth anniversary, it is fitting to hold a special remembrance of the Sacrament by means of the celebration of the proper Mass with the prayers indicated in The Roman Missal (Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions, 11. On the Anniversaries of Marriage). At the **Saturday evening Mass, on the second weekend of the month**, I will resume this practice, following the ritual. I ask that if you are celebrating a main anniversary, and wish to participate in this blessing for an anniversary, you contact the parish office. All couples will sit in the front pew(s) that will be reserved for you.

Relief parents, St. Nicholas Academy

St. Nicholas Academy is a supportive living experience for boys from families that are under-resourced who want to give their sons every opportunity to succeed in school and life. St. Nick's partners with families and St. Peter Inter-parish School to provide this opportunity. St. Nick's is seeking Christian, married couples or single individuals who are willing to be part of a pool of relief parents. The role of relief parents is to care for the boys and home when the full-time house parents are off duty or away.

Typically, the full-time house parents are off duty every fourth weekend from 9:00 AM Friday through 7:00 PM Sunday. Relief parents, on a rotational schedule, fill in during this time. They may also be asked to be on a call list to help fill in when the house parents are on vacation and/or sick.

Relief parents receive an hourly wage, all legally mandated benefits and a compensation package that includes a private suite and all meals for the days on duty.

We Are Called: How do we know when we are being called by God? Sometimes a call is very clear: this is what we need to do. Other times a call may be less obvious, and it may take more time to discern such a call. What is certain is that each of us will be called, at different times and in different ways, according to our personal strengths and weaknesses. While the prophets Isaiah and Jeremiah were called in dramatic visions, Elisha's call came with a simple but singular event: the prophet Elijah approached him as he was plowing and threw his cloak over him (1 Kings 19:19). Elisha immediately understood--this was a sign he was to follow Elijah and inherit his mantle as prophet.

We are familiar with how, at the beginning of his ministry, Jesus called the fishermen to follow him and how they dropped everything to do so. The events in today's Gospel happen much later, after Jesus has determined he is to go to Jerusalem, and--Luke informs the reader--there are already forebodings about his fate. Jesus is well enough known that some people approach him and want to go with him, but they are met with warnings about the difficulties that lie ahead. Others summoned by Jesus want to say good-bye to their families first; Jesus shrugs them off and continues on without them. The urgency of the task ahead demands immediate and total dedication.

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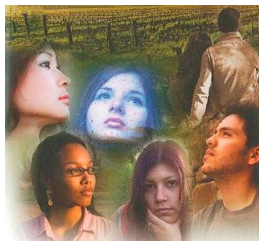

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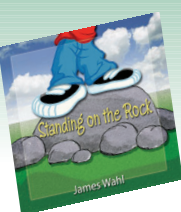
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
